## Air EMS Awarded Contract by U.S. Marshals Service

**Tulsa, OK** – Air EMS announced that the United States Marshals Service (USMS), has awarded the company a contract to provide in-flight medical services in support of its Justice Prisoner Air Transportation System (JPATS) division.

The award marks the second U.S. government air medical contract awarded to Air EMS in the past quarter, attesting to the company’s renewed strategic business development efforts and its established record of effective prime and sub-contract performance for federal agencies and commercial firms.

Celebrating its 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary, the Justice Prisoner Air Transportation System (JPATS) division has operational bases in Kansas City, MO and Oklahoma City, OK. JPATS is one of the largest dedicated transporters of prisoners in the world, averaging 265,000 prisoner movements per year on large and small jets.
